Q: Do I have to stop using my shower? and when can I start using it again after the work has been completed?

A: If the shower is leaking and causing damage then yes, it is preferable to stop using the shower. However, in most cases it is usually quite a gradual leak so therefore the difference will be minimal between the time we quote to the time the work is completed so it is certainly not a necessity, especially if you only have the use of one shower. Once the shower has been re-grouted it will be 24 hours before it can be reused.

Q: Should I have my shower screen replaced before or after the re-grouting?

A: If you are considering having the shower screen replaced it is recommended to have this done before the re-grouting work.

Ask one of the Grout Gals at Grout HQ or your local Grout Guy who we recommend.

Q: How long does the work take?

A: For standard shower re-grout, I would allow between 3-4 hours but it can vary depending on how hard the grout is to remove, size of the tiles, width of grout joints etc.

Q: Do you use mould resistant silicone and grout? A: Yes, we do have antifungal agents in both our grout and silicone.

Q: Do you clean tiles and grout?

A: No, unfortunately The Grout Guy does not provide cleaning services, we specialize in grout replacement. Ask one of the Grout Gals at Grout HQ or you your local Grout Guy who we recommend.

Water damage

Please refrain from repairing any water damaged areas for at least 10-12 months to allow enough drying time. If the water damaged area is repaired prematurely then in most instances the damage will reoccur due to the retained moisture. The drying time can vary depending on how long the shower has been leaking and how much moisture has been retained from the leak. Unfortunately, this is just simply a waiting game.
